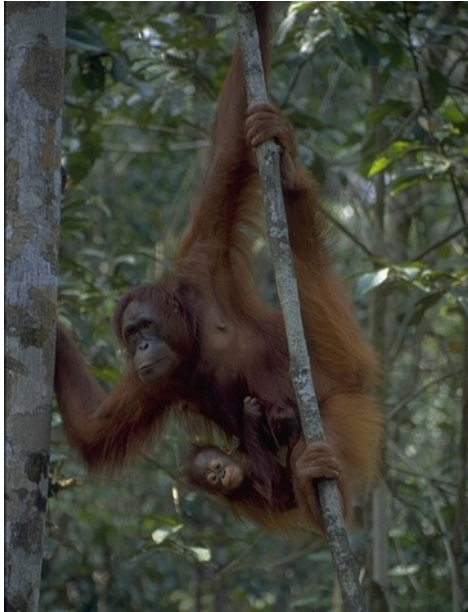


## Semenggoh Orangutan Tour & Lunch at a Bidayuh Village



0800 hours pick up from your hotel and depart for Semenggoh Wildlife Centre. Over 20 orangutans live in forest within the nature reserve and often return to the centre at feeding times. Upon arrival, take a short walk along a trail to the feeding area to watch the orangutans come down from the trees for a free meal.

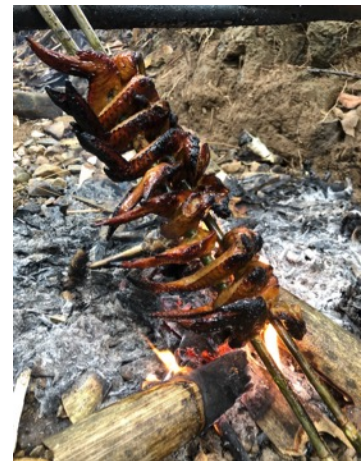
1030-1100 hours continue by road for 30 minutes to Peraya Bidayuh village in the Padawan area.

The Bidayuh or Land Dayak are the second largest Dayak tribe in Sarawak. Traditionally they lived in longhouses but today most Bidayuh settlements are villages with individual houses rather than longhouses.

Upon arrival meet your host family and enter the replica 'mini longhouse' made of wood and bamboo. A mountain-fed jungle stream flows past the homestay.

Enjoy a cup of tea or coffee or take a swim in the river.

Your hosts will prepare lunch, set up a BBQ and cook a range of local dishes in bamboo tubes. The lunch will be served in the longhouse or at a nearby pebble beach (depending on the weather).
